## **NCC ORGANISATION:**

The National Cadet Corps is headed by a Director General, an Army officer of the rank of Lieutenant General, who is responsible for the functioning of the National Cadet Corps in the country through the National Cadet Corps Headquarters situated at Delhi. At the State Level, the country has been divided into 17 directorates covering all states and union territories. Each of the State NCC Directorate Headquarters controls two to fourteen Group Headquarters. NCC Units are commanded by Major/Lieutenant Colonel or their equivalents.

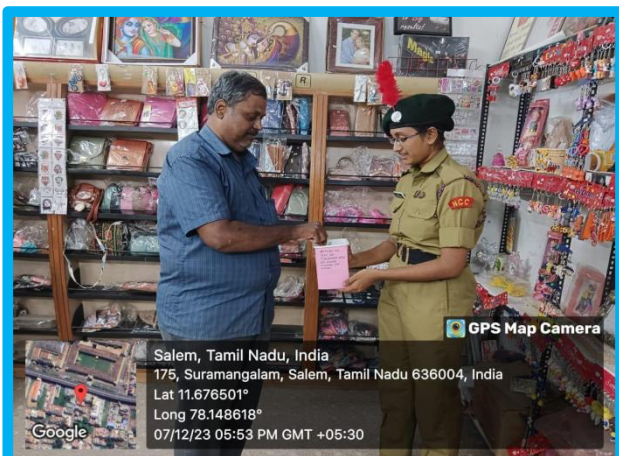
## COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAM: INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES
