
Objectives of Feedback

To provide students with the opportunity to express their views on the quality of their learning experience, as an integral part of the preparation for examination and evaluation process.


To assess the achievement of academic offerings in alignment with students' expectations.

To foster the comprehensive development of a student's personality, encompassing social and spiritual dimensions.


Feedback Process




UG STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS FOR THE YEAR 2023-24



From the chart it is clear that a majority of 45.56% of the students have opted excellent course content, 33.46 and 19.58% of the students have chosen very good and good respectively, 1.39% as average. With respect to extent of course content 36.19% of students have chosen excellent, 38.53 and 23% as very good and good, only 2.28% as average.



The chart indicates that majority 32.76% have stated that the applicability/relevance of the course to real life situation is excellent, 33.65% of the students have opined as very good, 29.15% as good and 4.44% as average. 30.23% have stated that the balance between theory and application is excellent, 36.25% of the students is of the opinion that it is very good, 28.90 and 4.63% as good and average respectively.






Majority of the students 33.52 and 23.70% have given the overall rating as excellent and very good, followed by the rating as good and average.















SUBJECT EXPERT FEEDBACK ANALYSIS FOR THE YEAR 2023-24 UG PROGRAMME















ALUMNAE FEEDBACK ANALYSIS FOR THE YEAR 2023-24




From the alumni feedback analysis on curriculum frame work and extent of syllabus content reveals that majority respondents gave excellent and very good.




