Students Satisfaction Survey Report (2019-2020)

The students are an integral part of the institution. The prime measure of a college's development can be easily interpreted by the satiety of student. In order to capture the experiences of students for the academic session 2019-2020, a questionnaire of 36 parameters has been framed and forwarded online. The survey includes 36 competency based questions to which responses are given anonymously by the students of the institution. The survey components include an institute level feedback on infrastructure and learning experiences. We conducted SSS during the month of May 2019.

The result of the survey will help the institution to understand both short and long term needs of the students and initiate remedial action to improve the facilities whenever and wherever it is required. The outcome of the survey will provide a base to plan for the future.

The students answered all the questions in the survey with their sincere thought and effort. Totally 1816 students participated in the survey from various programmes.

The analysis of the survey conducted shows that, the satisfaction level of students with respect to facilities provided in the campus is extremely satisfied by 854 out of 1816 students. Students have expressed satisfaction over the quantum of syllabus covered in their classes and laboratories.

The survey conducted on the parameters like Counseling/ Mentoring service/ Redressal of grievances in the College/Department, internships and related activities, placement training and related activities in the college revealed with overall satisfaction and highly satisfied by ¾ of the students' community. At the same time the students highly appreciated and satisfied with the implementation of learning outcome based curriculum which includes continuous evaluation, assessment of assignment, seminar works and its follow up made by the faculty throughout the semester.




The overall observation from the survey are as follows:

- 4. Teachers should encourage students to participate in extra-curricular activities and encourage research culture among the students.


1. What degree program are you pursuing now?




2. What subject area are you currently pursuing?




3. How satisfied are you with the facilities provided by the college?






5. Do you think faculty and support staff at the college were helpful?




