Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>Sri Sarada College for Women (Autonomous) Salem - 16, affiliated to Periyar University prepares the College Calendar based on the University's Academic Calendar. The College Calendar provides date of commencement of the academic session, duration of Semester, period of Continuous Internal Assessment Test (CIA), End Semester Exam etc. The Departments allocate subjects to teachers and prepare time table. The teachers prepare the teaching materials and deliver the content. The teaching plan is prepared by the individual Department. Three Internal Tests, a Model and Final Semester Exams are conducted. The regularity in the conduct of the tests and examination and declaration of results are centralized. The College ensures that the student community is provided with adequate opportunities to meet the outcomes expected. During Covid-19 pandemic from August 2020 to July 2021 the teaching and learning process were conducted through Virtual Mode. Classes were conducted through MS teams, Google Meet and Zoom Meet. Tests and Exams were conducted online and WhatsApp Groups were also created to establish the connectivity of the students with the Course Teachers. The readiness of the learners to the sudden change in the method of teaching and learning process proved to be very successful.</p> <p>Since the examination process is automated, the questions are generated and the evaluation processes were also made easy and time bound. Thus planning paves way to ensure credibility and outcome of assessment system. UG and PG students were asked to write their exams and scan their answer scripts and send to the course teachers for evaluation. PG projects viva-voce examinations were conducted online. In addition technology is used as a learning resource – Online Open Access Journals are provided to all the students to read and update their knowledge relevant to their courses.</p> <p>The first year students were admitted in UG and PG Programmes in the month of September 2021 and November 2021. Teachers provided the students with more number of learning experience by available technology, after expanding their knowledge on preparing Technological tools by attending various programmes like Webinars, FDPs, Orientations etc. Our Faculty members have earned e-certificates during the pandemic and totally have received 1276 certificates. The College and its Allied Associations/Cells conducted Webinars, Quizzes, Workshops, Student Seminars, SIP, Bridge/Refresher Courses and different academic programmes online. These were very much possible with the teachers' familiarity with Learning Management Systems (LMS). Thus teachers took the initiative to learn the latest technology and strive for the individual and institutional excellence. The students and parents co-operated with the unexpected changes in the teaching and learning processes to complete all our academic activities as planned. Students were motivated to take up MOOC, NPTEL and Internships in addition to their courses to earn more credits.</p> <p>At research level too, as per the instruction of the Periyar University Ph. D Viva Voce Examinations are conducted through Online and thirteen scholars have completed their Viva-voce successfully. Our faculty members have published 43 papers in Journals, 10 chapters in Edited Books and 3 Books. Thus the institution adhered to the plan.</p>
